WHAT IS BEPP?

The Building Energy Performance Program (BEPP), established through the Building Energy Performance Policy, is designed to improve energy and water efficiency in Philadelphia's largest non-residential buildings. Often referred to as "building tune-ups," BEPP helps building owners reduce energy consumption and operating costs while enhancing overall performance.

ELIGIBILITY & COMPLIANCE PROCESS

→ September 30, 2024 (PAST DUE)

- ◆ Tune-up report deadline for 50,000–70,000 sq. ft. buildings.
- ◆ Tune-up specialists submitting 2024 reports must be certified by this date.

→ January 3, 2026

- ◆ Updated alternative compliance plans for large portfolios are due.

→ April 4, 2026

- ◆ Deadline for certifying high performance, requesting an alternative exemption, and making extension requests for buildings over 200,000 sq. ft.

→ September 30, 2026

- ◆ Tune-up report deadline for buildings over 200,000 sq. ft.
- ◆ Tune-up specialists submitting 2026 reports must be certified by this date.

HOW CAN LIMBACH HELP?

Conduct comprehensive tune-ups to optimize existing building systems

Certify high-performance buildings with LEED Gold or Platinum Certifications, Net-Zero Energy Certification, or Retro-Commissioning

Apply to eligible utility rebates derived from **project savings**



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
